### Reforms Brought by Lord Cornwallis - History Discussion

In 2005, the UPA government appointed the second administrative reforms commission which over a period of 4 years came out with 11 thick volumes of analysis and recommendations for administrative reforms. Like most committees these reports are gathering dust and the idea of administrative reforms has faded from public discourse.

### PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION: Administrative reforms in India

Public Administration Reform can be very comprehensive and include process changes in areas such as organisational structures, decentralisation, personnel management, public finance, results-based management, regulatory reforms etc. It can also refer to targeted reforms such as the revision of the civil service statute.

### Public Administration Reform

Baring's mandate in Egypt was to carry out wide-scale administrative reforms in a country that was bankrupt and had just gone through a popular revolution and a foreign occupation, and eventually to effect the evacuation of the British forces stationed there. Quickly he concluded that reforms and evacuation were incompatible, that reforms were of more lasting value to the mass of the Egyptians, and that evacuation should come only in the distant future when the Egyptians had been taught ...
