The mandibular second premolars tend to be single-rooted with a single centred type 1 canal, which is wide in a buccolingual direction (Fig. 1.64). Two canals occur in 25% of cases, when the floor of the pulp chamber extends well below the cervical level with canal configurations of type 2, 3 or 4 in that order.

INTRODUCTION: Congenitally missing second mandibular premolars are the second most frequent type of agenesis, after the third molar, with an incidence of 2.5% to 5% of the population in the USA and Europe.¹⁻⁵ Unilateral versus bilateral lower second premolar agenesis has been reported to consist up to 60% of the agenesis cases.⁵⁻⁹
