The User Guide updates confirm that Responsible Reporting Entities and agents will be provided the MBI in all Section 111 reporting response files (including query files). Beginning in April 2018, query files will begin to see a combination of HICNs and MBIs so RREs and agents will need to be capable of distinguishing between the two and identifying claimants accordingly.
