### Real Estate Tax Relief and Exemptions | Tax Administration

The Charitable Nonprofit Housing Property Exemption, Public Act 612 of 2006, MCL 211.7kk, as amended, was created to exempt certain residential property owned by a charitable nonprofit housing organization from property taxes for a maximum period of five years if the property is intended for ultimate occupancy by low-income persons as a principal residence.

### Taxes - Property Tax Exemptions - Michigan

Organizations engaged primarily in charitable activities and 501(c)(2) corporations that hold title to property for such organizations may be eligible for a local option property tax exemption.

### Primarily Charitable Organizations Eligible for Property ...

Exemptions. Acting on constitutional authority, the Tennessee General Assembly authorized certain property tax exemptions for Tennessee's religious, charitable, scientific, literary and nonprofit educational organizations. With limited exception, no organization is automatically exempt from the payment of property taxes, but rather must apply to and be approved by the Tennessee State Board of Equalization.
